What are the Eligibility Criteria?

- Earned a Bachelor's degree in discipline relevant to their proposed graduate study using English as a medium of instruction in the past 5 years;
- Earned a minimum cumulative grade point of 2.75 on a 4.0 (or its equivalent);
- Be a citizen and permanent resident of Djibouti, Somalia, South Sudan & Eretrian refugees in Ethiopia;
- Male applicants with disabilities
- Female applicants with economic difficulty.
